
Creative Coding

Any coding language is OK, whether its Python, Perl, C, C++, Java, Javascript, Basic, Scratch or anything else.

Electronics and digital making

In a similar style to Fablabs, there will be facilities to enable creative technology development.

Moreton Creative will be a centre for technology innovation and inspiration.

We will have digital fabrication equipment such as 3D printers.

Come and learn how to make use of micro-controllers such as Arduino, build a robot or make a new invention.



Repair Café



A regular repair café is planned. People will be able to use this facility to bring in broken items such as clothing, toys, electronic devices and tools. They will then have the guidance of skilled volunteers and access to tools to enable them to fix the items in exchange for donations to

IT support and Technology Advice

Moretonhampstead IT surgery which offers IT advice and guidance will now be hosted by Moreton Creative.

The IT Surgery gives an opportunity to people with computer problems and queries:

- Should I upgrade my computer?
- Is my computer safe from hackers and viruses?
- Are my documents safe or should I back them up?
- Are my personal details safe when I enter them online?



Independent advice about technology can be hard to come by and consumers are often sold more than they need by sales representatives. MC will also provide a regular drop in session (Moreton's Tech Advice) where people can get independent advice about technology and purchases such as phones and computers in exchange for a donation.

Courses

The Moreton Creative space can host courses on any topics from computers or digital making to music or art. This may include one-off workshops and weekly evening classes. Such courses will be organised by private tutors or educational establishments.

Hot-desking

Need some space away from the distractions of home to work? Desks will be available for hire on an hourly, daily, and weekly basis.



Games nights

This room used to be host to a billiard table in days gone past. Moreton Creative can bring back some of that experience by hosting games evenings. This could include table top games, and keeping up with current trends and technology, also computer games, and could involve any age groups.
